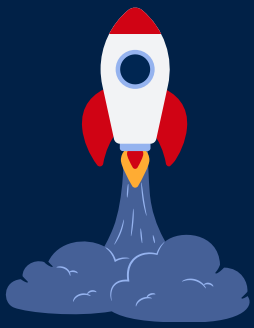


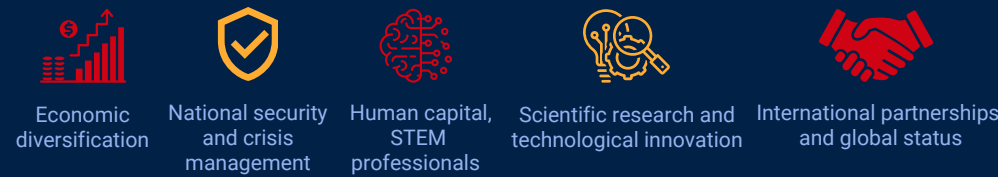
UAE'S SPACE SECTOR

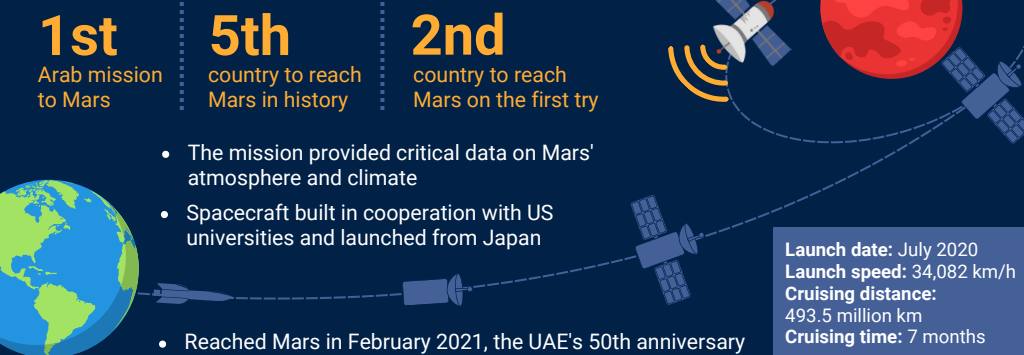
